Customary international human rights

Do we need to interpret the CISG in light of the principles set out in the international human rights instruments?

Effect of human rights instruments on the CISG

Art. 35.1 - quality of the goods

Minimal ethical standards = rights under customary law

e.g., prohibition of child labor, or promotion of sustainable development

Seller is required to produce goods in line with these standards

Non-minimal ethical standards

Art. 8 - Have the parties agreed on using these rights?

Art. 9.1 and Art. 9.2 - use of trade usages that are industrcy specific (e.g. electric industry)

The idea:

Because the CISG is part of the international legal framework, human rights have to be used to interpret the CISG
